ONTARIO SIRES STAKES

The Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) program was established in 1974. The objective of the program is to promote the breeding of Standardbred horses in Ontario and provide economic incentives for breeders, owners and trainers to breed, buy and race horses in Ontario.

The OSS is part of the Standardbred (SIP) component of Ontario's Horse Improvement Program (HIP) which was established in 1968 and is currently administered by Ontario Racing.

The Ontario Sires Stakes program consists of a series of races for two and three-year-old trotters and pacers, held at racetracks across Ontario from May to October of each year.

The program is funded through a levy imposed on wagering at the rate of 3% of total wagering by customers in Ontario (Home Market Area wagering). The purses are further enhanced by stallion levies, nomination and sustaining payments, and starting fees.

OSS Program

NEW FOR 2023

- Prospect Series Leg purses are \$8,000 per division, with \$4,000 contributed from HIP and \$4,000 from the host racetrack.
- Gold Super Final purses are \$300,000 per age, sex and gait category.
- Grassroots Championship purses are \$75,000 per age, sex and gait category.
- All starters in Gold Series Legs will receive a share of the purse. The winner of the race will receive 50 per cent (50%) of the total purse; one per cent (1%) of the total purse will be paid to each horse finishing sixth through last; the remainder of the purse for the race will be divided 50-24-16-10% for the horses finishing second through fifth.

ADMINISTRATION AND REGULATION

Ontario Racing serves as the Program Administrator for the Standardbred Horse Improvement Program (SIP), which includes the OSS Program.

Since 2019 Ontario Racing has served as the representative voice of the province's horse racing industry. The organization, governed by a Board of Directors representing all facets of the industry, is responsible for directing breed improvement programs, setting an annual program of races and purses, attracting new owners, building the fan base and connecting the industry and the general public. Ontario Racing also works closely with the Ontario Lottery and Gaming (OLG) Corporation towards the integration of horse racing into OLG's gaming strategy.

The 2023 OSS program was developed by the SIP Committee, made up of representatives of the racing and breeding community, which is tasked with providing input and recommendations on Program components.

In 2023 the OSS offers three tiers of racing – Gold, Grassroots and Prospect Series'. Each tier offers preliminary legs and finals for two- and three-year-old trotters and pacers. Complete descriptions of each series can be found on pages 16 to 21.

Ontario Racing, as Program Administrator, reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to make any adjustments, changes or cancellations to the OSS Program as deemed required. By participating in the OSS Program, participants acknowledge and agree that Ontario Racing will not be held liable for any costs associated with any changes to the OSS Program.

All OSS races shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Standardbred Racing and individual racetrack rules approved by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO). All participants are strongly advised to make themselves familiar with rules specifically related to the OSS.

JOHNSTON CUP

The Johnston Cup was founded in 1993 in memory of Bruce Johnston, the publisher of The Canadian Sportsman. It is awarded yearly to the leading trainer in the Ontario Sires Stakes based on the following point system:

One point is awarded for each OSS start. Four additional points are awarded for a win, three for a second and two for a third-place finish.

The Gold Series

The Gold Series will consist of five (5) Legs for each of the eight (8) age, sex, and gait categories and a Super Final for the top point earners through the five Legs. Horses will be awarded points in each Leg as follows:

First Place	50 points	Fifth Place	5 points
Second Place	25 points	Sixth Place	3 points
Third Place	12 points	Seventh Place	2 points
Fourth Place	8 points	Eighth Place	1 point

In the event of a dead heat, the points for the positions involved will be shared evenly between the horses finishing in the dead heat.

Point standings are updated daily on the Standardbred Canada computer system and on the OSS website.

- Each Gold Series Leg will be numbered and horses cannot be entered into a Gold, Grassroots or Prospect Series event of the same number
- Starting Fees for a Gold Series Leg are \$900 and are added to the purse.
- If more horses declare to start in a Gold Leg than is permitted for an Added Money event at that racetrack, the event shall be split into the appropriate number of divisions with entries seeded by lot. The number of starters will adhere to Rule 16.24 in the AGCO Rules of Standardbred Racing. The maximum size of fields permitted in any added money event shall be:
 - a) For races which go in one division, no more than two trailers
 - b) For races which go in more than one division, a maximum of one trailer.

An Association may elect to go with less than the number of trailers specified in (a) above.

■ The purse for each Gold Series Leg is \$190,000, split between divisions, unless a single division with 10 or fewer horses at Woodbine Mohawk Park or no more than one trailer at all other racetracks is required, in which case the purse will be \$150,000.

All starters in Gold Series Legs will receive a share of the purse. The winner of the race will receive 50 per cent (50%) of the total purse; one per cent (1%) of the total purse will be paid to each horse finishing sixth through last; the remainder of the purse for the race will be divided 50-24-16-10% for the horses finishing second through fifth.

Gold Super Final Rules

- Each of the eight (8) categories of age, sex and gait will have a Gold Super Final for the top point earners (see above for point breakdown).
- Any horse may be entered into its respective Gold Super Final, provided it has started in a minimum of two (2) Gold Series Legs in the current year OR has earned a minimum of 50 points in the Gold Series in the current year.
- Any horse may be entered into its respective Gold Super Final, Grassroots Semi-Final or Prospect Series Final, but it cannot be entered into more than one Semi-Final/ Final, unless it was "Also Eligible" and did not draw in.
- After the last scheduled Gold Series Leg, the top 10 point earners in each age, sex and gait category which are entered for the Gold Super Final will compete for a purse of \$300,000.
- The two "Also Eligible" horses will be the 11th and 12th highest point earners entered in.
- In the event of a tie in the point standings, horses will be drawn by lot after the box closes.
- There will be a maximum of 10 horses in Gold Super Final events.
- There will be no Starting Fee for the Gold Super Finals.
- The purse for each Gold Super Final is \$300,000 and all starters will receive a share of the purse. The winner of the race will receive fifty per cent (50%) of the total purse; one per cent (1%) of the total purse will be paid to each horse finishing sixth through last; the remainder of the purse for the race will be divided 50-24-16-10% for the horses finishing second through fifth.

The Grassroots Series

■ The Grassroots Series will consist of five (5) Legs for each of the eight (8) age, sex, and gait categories, along with Grassroots Semi-Finals and a Grassroots Championship for the top point earners through the five Legs. Horses will be awarded points in each Leg as follows:

First Place	50 points	Fifth Place	5 points
Second Place	25 points	Sixth Place	3 points

In the event of a dead heat, the points for the positions involved will be shared evenly between the horses finishing in the dead heat.

Point standings are updated daily on the Standardbred Canada computer system and on the OSS website.

- Each Grassroots Series Leg will be numbered and horses cannot be entered into a Gold, Grassroots or Prospect Series event of the same number.
- Starting Fees for a Grassroots Series Leg are \$400 and are added to the purse.
- The purse for each Grassroots Series division is \$19,000.
- In Grassroots Series Leg divisions with 11 starters or multiple trailers, all starters will receive a share of the purse. The winner will receive 50% of the total; sixth through last will receive 1% of the total; the remainder will be divided 50-24-16-10% for second through fifth.
- If more horses declare to start in a Grassroots Series Leg than is permitted for an added money event at that racetrack, the event shall be split into the appropriate number of divisions with entries seeded by lot. The number of starters will adhere to Rule 16.24 in the AGCO Rules of Standardbred Racing as detailed on page 16.

Grassroots Semi-Final & Championship Rules

 Each of the eight (8) categories of age, sex and gait will have Grassroots Semi-Finals and a Grassroots Championship for the top point earners (see above for point breakdown).

- Any horse may be entered into its respective Grassroots Semi-Final, provided it has started in a minimum of two (2) Grassroots Series Legs in the current year.
- Any horse may be entered into its respective Gold Super Final, Grassroots Semi-Final or Prospect Series Final, but it cannot be entered into more than one Semi-Final/ Final, unless it was "Also Eligible" and did not draw in.
- After the last scheduled Grassroots Series Leg, the top point earners in each age, sex and gait category, which are entered, will compete in two Semi-Final divisions.
- The two "Also Eligible" horses will be drawn from the next highest point earners entered in and they will be the same for both Semi-Final divisions.
- In the event of a tie in the point standings, horses will be drawn by lot after the box closes.
- Starters in the Championship, held approximately one week after the Semi-Finals, will be the top finishers in the Semi-Final divisions that enter in. In the event of a tie for the final position, the starters will be drawn by lot. A dead heat may not cause the number of starters to increase. Horses finishing in a dead heat are considered to have finished the same. Horses finishing in a dead heat will be ranked behind horses finishing in the same position but not in a dead heat.
- The next highest placed finishers entered in will be the first and second "Also Eligible" horses in the Championship. In the event of a tie they will be drawn by lot.
- The number of starters allowed to start in the Grassroots Semi-Finals and Championships will be governed by the number of horses the host racetrack can accommodate on the starting gate. However, there will be a minimum of eight horses drawn for each age, sex and gait category.
- There will be no Starting Fee for the Grassroots Semi-Finals or Championships.
- The purse for each Grassroots Semi-Final is \$20,000,
- The purse for each Grassroots Championship is \$75,000 and all starters will receive a share of the purse. The winner of the race will receive 50% of the total; sixth through last will receive 1% of the total; the remainder will be divided 59-24-16-10% for second through fifth.

The Prospect Series will consist of eight (8) Legs for each of the eight (8) age, sex, and gait categories and a Prospect Final for the top point earners through the five Legs. Horses will be awarded points in each Leg as follows:

In the event of a dead heat, the points for the positions involved will be shared evenly between the horses finishing in the dead heat.

Point standings are updated weekly on the Standardbred Canada computer system and on the OSS website.

- Each Prospect Series Leg will be numbered and horses cannot be entered into a Gold, Grassroots or Prospect Series event of the same number. Three of the Prospect Series Legs will offer two racing opportunities, denoted as Leg #A and #B. Horses that enter Gold/Grassroots Leg 1, for example, will not be eligible for Prospect Series Leg 1A or 1B.
- A minimum of five (5) horses must enter in for a Prospect Series Leg to be contested. Should a Prospect Series Leg fail to fill, horses may enter in the corresponding Gold or Grassroots event. All horses entered into a Prospect Series Leg that fails to fill shall receive five (5) points.
- Starting fees for a Prospect Series Leg are \$100 and are added to the purse.
- The purse for each Prospect Series division is \$8,000.
- If more horses declare to start in a Prospect Series Leg than is permitted for an Added Money event at that racetrack, the event shall be split into the appropriate number of divisions with entries seeded by lot. The number of starters will adhere to Rule 16.24 in the AGCO 2018 Rules of Standardbred Racing. The maximum size of fields permitted in any added money event shall be:
 - a) For races which go in one division, no more than two trailers

b) For races which go in more than one division, a maximum of one trailer.

An Association may elect to go with less than the number of trailers specified in (a) above.

 Prospect Series Legs and Finals do not contribute toward Johnston and Lampman Cup point totals or Breeders' Rewards.

Prospect Final Rules

- Each of the eight (8) categories of age, sex and gait will have a Prospect Final for the top point earners (see above for point breakdown).
- Any horse may be entered into its respective Prospect Final, provided it has started in a minimum of THREE (3)
 Prospect Series Legs in the current year.
- Any horse may be entered into its respective Gold Super Final, Grassroots Semi-Final or Prospect Series Final, but it cannot be entered into more than one Semi-Final/ Final, unless it was "Also Eligible" and did not draw in.
- After the last scheduled Prospect Series Leg, the top point earners in each age, sex and gait category which are entered for the Prospect Final will compete for a purse of \$15,000.
- The next highest placed finishers entered in will be the first and second "Also Eligible" horses.
- In the event of a tie in the point standings, horses will be drawn by lot after the box closes.
- The number of starters allowed to start in the Prospect Finals will be governed by the number of horses the host racetrack can accommodate on the starting gate. However, there will be a minimum of eight horses drawn for each age, sex and gait category.

- There will be no Starting Fee for the Prospect Final.
- The purse for each Prospect Final is \$15,000.

Rules & Conditions

RULES OF STANDARDBRED RACING RELATED TO THE OSS

The following rules are subject to any Temporary Rule Amendments published by the AGCO.

RULE 11.02.01 (Qualifying Times)

If a horse meets the conditions of Rule 11.01 it will be considered qualified and eligible to be declared to added money event races provided that one of its last three charted lines is a clean line in a purse, qualifying or schooling race, not more than sixty (60) clear days before the closing of declarations and its individual time in that clean charted line meets the following standards for age and the size of the track where it raced or qualified after the judges have given appropriate allowances for track conditions on that day.

RULE 11.02.02 — Notwithstanding the provisions of 11.02.01, no horse shall be considered qualified and eligible to be declared to added money event races if that horse, since having obtained the clean charted line referred to in 11.02.01, is required to qualify in accordance with the rules, including Chapter 12 where applicable, or is on the Judges' List or is otherwise ineligible to race.

RULE 12.10.01 — A horse making a break in each of two consecutive races must qualify unless the breaks were equipment breaks or caused by interference.

12.10.02 — A horse making a break off a qualifier or its second consecutive break in a row in an elimination heat will be allowed to race in the final.

12.10.03 —Any horse that makes a break in stride on anything but a fast track, such as good, sloppy, snow, or heavy, shall be considered a clean line. Any horse charted with 3 consecutive breaks must qualify regardless of track condition.

12.10.04 — Any horse participating in a qualifier that is currently qualified shall not become ineligible to be entered in a subsequent race should it be charted with a break in the unnecessary qualifier.

RULE 17.15 (a)(iv) — If the horse omitted by error was declared to a stake, futurity, early closing event or late closing event, the race shall be re-drawn provided the error is discovered prior to the printing of the program.

Any questions or inquiries concerning the Rules of Standardbred Racing should be directed to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) at 416-326-8700 or iagco.agco.ca.

OSS RACING CONDITIONS

All races shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) and all participants are strongly advised to make themselves familiar with the rules. Complete Rules of Standardbred Racing can be found at agco.ca/horse-racing/books/rules-standardbred-racing.

Horses sustained to the OSS program may be subject to testing under the Out Of Competition Program. Racetrack retention barn rules may apply.

Should conditions beyond the control of Ontario Racing prevent the racing of any event, Ontario Racing reserves the right to declare the event "off" and to distribute the money and points to the current eligible horses or to transfer the event to another date, or to another racetrack, or to do both.

In the event of a "No Contest" in an OSS race, the purse and points for that race will be split evenly between all unoffending horses.

STARTING FEE PAYMENT

The Starting Fee must be received in the Race Office of the host racetrack one-half (1/2) hour prior to post time. Cheques should be made payable to "Ontario Sires Stakes". The Starting Fee is still due in the event that a horse must be scratched for whatever reason.

Eligibility & rewards

In 2023, more than \$17.7 million will be available in rewards and purses through the Ontario Sires Stakes and Breeders' Reward programs.

To be eligible for participation in the Ontario Sires Stakes program, offspring of registered Ontario Sires must be nominated and sustained to the program (see inside back cover for key dates).

Registered Ontario Sires must be owned or leased by an Ontario resident and enrolled in the program by Jan. 15 of the breeding season. Late enrolments are accepted so long as the stallion has not bred any mares prior to enrolling. A total of \$100,000 in breeders' rewards will be distributed to the owners of leading Ontario Sires in 2023.

A total of \$2.53 million will be distributed in 2023 to breeders who enrolled their mares in the Ontario Resident Mare Program (ORMP) for the 2020 and 2021 foaling seasons. Those offspring earn the designation of Ontario Bred. The owner(s) or lessee(s) who enrolled the mare in the ORMP for that foaling year will receive the Ontario Bred Rewards

For those mares enrolled in the ORMP program that produced Ontario Sired offspring, a total of \$2 million in breeders' rewards will be distributed on a pro rata basis according to their offspring's OSS earnings. An additional \$400,000 will be distributed to the breeders of the leading OSS performers who are Ontario Bred.

For those mares enrolled in the ORMP program whose offspring were either Ontario Sired or by sires standing outside Ontario, a total of \$130,000 will be distributed on a pro rata basis according to success in select open stake events, with an individual cap of 20% of the total available per horse.

Ontario Bred Rewards for OSS races are paid out in August and at the end of the year. Ontario Bred Rewards for open stakes are paid out at the end of the year.


